

## Transkentucky Transportation Railroad (TTI Railroad) Tour



When: Friday, May 15, 2015 from 8:15 AM – 12:00 PM

Where: TTI Railroad Yard and Roundhouse in Paris, Ky

What: This is an exclusive tour of the TTI Railroad's yard area, roundhouse/maintenance facility with an operational turntable, their fuel/sanding racks, and their freight trans-load facility located in Paris, Kentucky. The facilities in use at TTI are an excellent example of traditional railroad maintenance facilities from the steam and early diesel eras that have been adapted for modern day use. The TTI rosters a fleet of GE U-Boat and Dash-7 diesels, all of which are maintained at the Paris facility. The railroad was originally built as part of the Kentucky Central Railroad, which ultimately was merged into the L&N. The TTI was created in order to take over the line from the L&N between Paris and Maysville, Kentucky for the purpose of moving coal to a barge trans-load facility on the Ohio River. Although the coal business has dwindled in recent years, the railroad still has a few agricultural customers and has also been actively growing their other trans-load business. The new trans-load business in Paris is a rail to truck/truck to rail operation and plays a major role in the company's current business portfolio. This tour will include ample photo opportunities off of the bus in a controlled environment.

Required: Sturdy boots and long pants must be worn. All participants must be at least 18 years of age and must ride the bus; no private automobiles will be permitted. A liability release may be required. Optional: Any other Personal Protective Equipment
